Dear St. Lawrence School Families,

Catholic Schools Week is just around the corner! This year, it will be from Monday, January 30th to Friday, February 3rd. We will be kicking off the week with our annual Book Fair and Art Show in Deacon Hall after our masses this Saturday and Sunday, January 28th and 29th. We will also be having a Coffee Social after the 9:30 AM and 11:00 AM masses on Sunday.

During Catholic Schools Week, our students will again be volunteering at local nursing homes, community centers, and humanitarian aid facilities. This will give every student the opportunity to help others and learn about the importance of giving back to our community. We will also be having some spirit days in celebration of Catholic Schools Week. On these spirit days, students will be allowed to dress in clothing to represent various themes. Please refer to the costume guidelines below this newsletter before choosing clothing for these days. One of our spirit day events allows students to participate in a Crazy Hair Day. On this day, students will be allowed to style their hair in a fun, creative way. We ask that students come to school in their hair style for the day. No students should need to use the school bathroom to style their hair. Students are allowed to color their hair, but no hair coloring or aerosol cans or bottles of any kind should be brought into the school building. The parent portal of My Students Progress closed on Friday to give teachers the ability to begin creating and entering data for the second quarter report cards. Please feel free to contact your child’s teacher if you would like to view any assignments while the portal is closed. The portal will reopen on Tuesday, February 7th when report cards become available. Report cards are made available electronically at the end of each quarter. The fourth quarter report card is the only report card that is sent home as a hard copy. Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies, and Religion are given report card grades each quarter. Physical Education, Technology, Art, and Music are given report card grades once per semester, at the end of the second and the fourth quarter. The Diocesan report cards do not provide us with the ability to grade Character Education and Library. The second quarter ends this Friday, January 27th.

I am excited to announce that we will again be participating in the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Rochester this year. The parade will begin at 12:30 PM on Saturday, March 11th. We will be marching with other Catholic schools in the Diocese. Please save the date, and we will provide you with more information as it becomes available.
