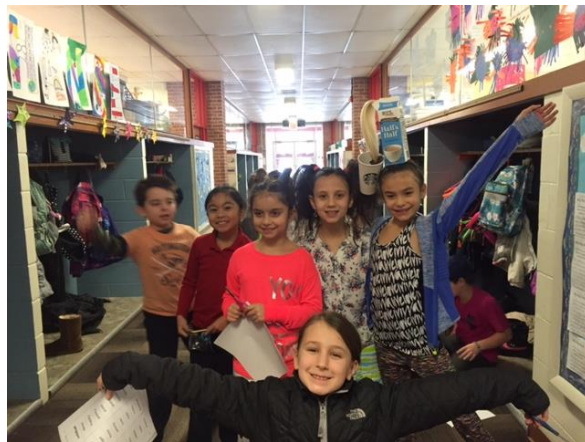
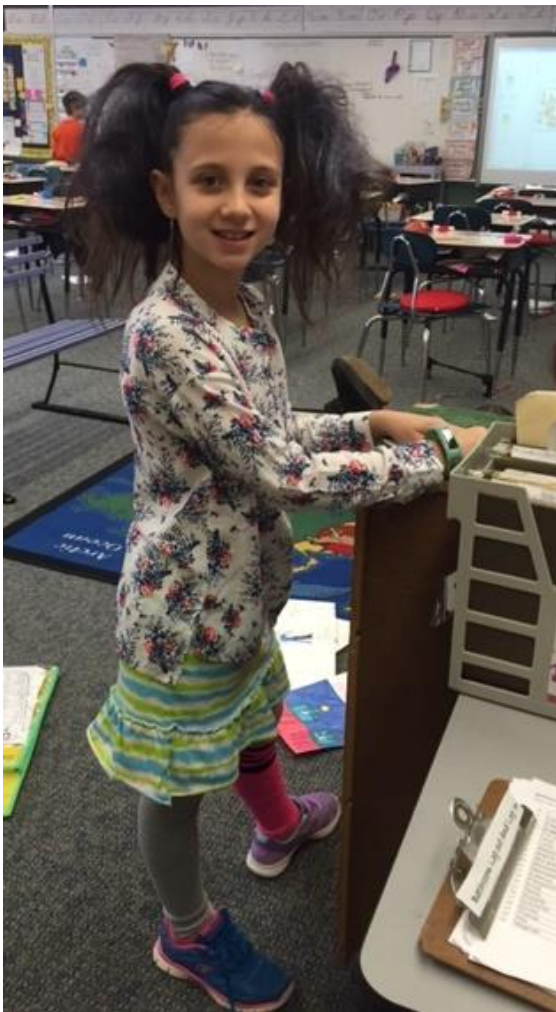
Current family registration forms are due Friday, 2/10 at 3pm. After this date we will begin to accept registration from new families.

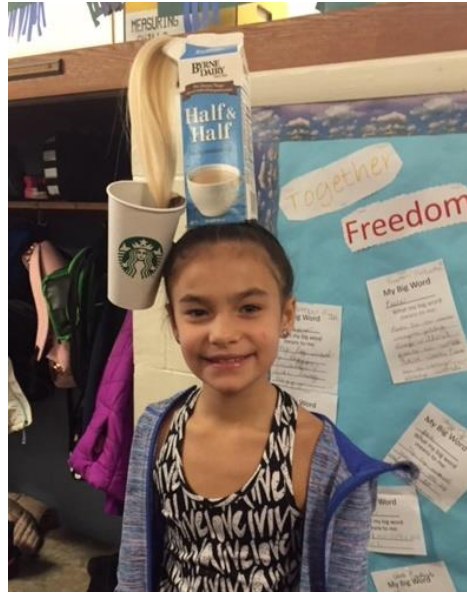
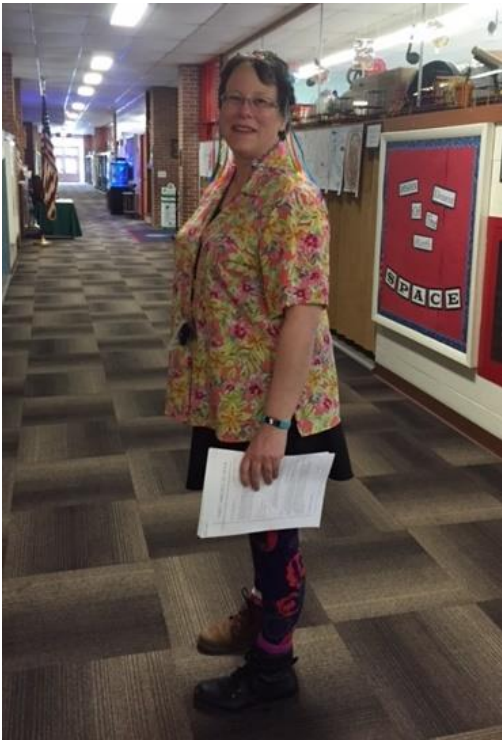
If you haven't already, please remember to send in your child's permission slip for roller skating by Friday morning. All students must have a helmet in order to skate.
