Dear St. Lawrence School Families,

St. Lawrence School is again using the I-Ready program to evaluate the reading and math levels of every child in grades K-5. These are online assessments that help our teachers assess student progress in ELA and math. This information is also used by our Academic Intervention Services Teachers to determine which students will be receiving AIS and Enrichment this year. Each of these tests takes approximately two class periods to complete. The mid-year I-Ready assessments conclude on Monday, January 22nd. There is one math test this week. These tests are not in any way factored into your child's report card grade. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact your child's teacher.

Please remember that a dress down day is a day when students are not required to wear their school uniform. On dress down days, students should not be wearing accessories such as hats, light up shoes, or sunglasses. There may be opportunities for students to wear these types of special accessories on spirit days throughout the year, but these are not the same as dress down days. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school office or your child's teacher.
