If you are unable to log into the My Students Progress website, please contact the school office. The parent portal of My Students Progress closed when the first quarter ended last Friday to give teachers the ability to begin creating and entering data for the first quarter report cards. Please feel free to contact your child's teacher if you would like to view any assignments while the portal is closed. The portal will reopen on Tuesday, November 20th when report cards become available. Report cards for grades K-5 are made available electronically at the end of each quarter. Preschool report cards are available at the end of each semester, following the second and fourth quarters of the school year. The fourth quarter report card is the only report card that is sent home as a hard copy. Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies, and Religion are given report card grades each quarter for grades K-5 and each semester for Preschool. Physical Education, Technology, Art, and Music are given report card grades once per semester, at the end of the second and fourth quarters.

Our library program is officially up and running! Ms. Milano and Mrs. Carlson have been working with our students in grades K-5 to help them begin learning how to take out and return books. All K-5 students will have an opportunity to visit the library once a week. We are so excited to have our library up and running again this year!
