**Reminders From The Main Office**

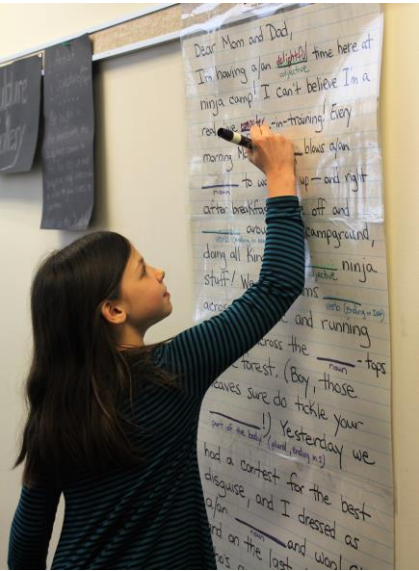
