Request from the Health Office

If you received a green Student Health Services Information Form in your child's Tuesday Envelope today, it means I did not receive the original form back (forms were sent home in March). Please complete and return ASAP so that I can update your child's cumulative health record.

With the new regulations regarding mandated 'health appraisal' reports from your child's Health Care Provider, we are basically asking for reports for every grade level at St. Lawrence, except from those students going into 2nd and 4th grade. You don't need to wait till August to turn the appraisal reports in. I have limited hours at school over the summer, and with few exceptions, the health appraisals your child has had done this school year will fulfill the obligation for the 2018-2019 school year. Please turn in any completed paperwork (immunizations, health appraisals...) now.
